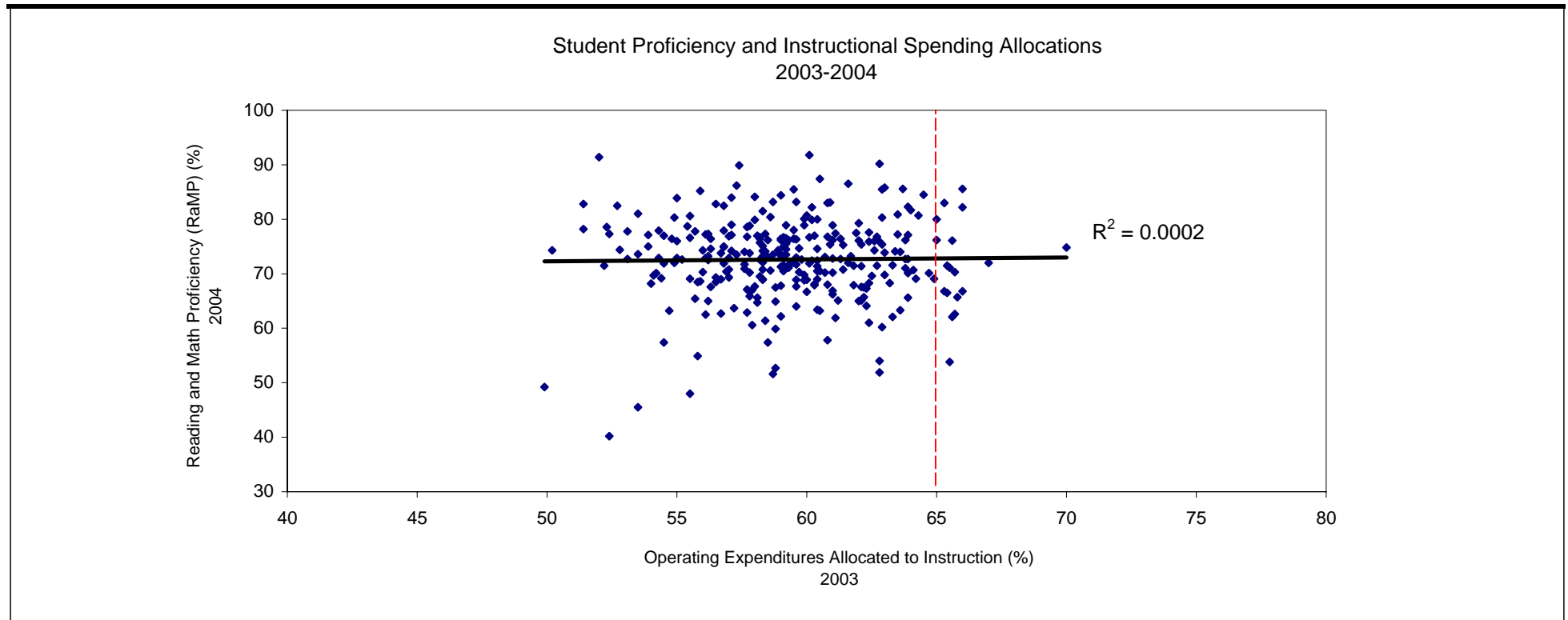


Indiana School Districts

About This Graph: This scatterplot illustrates the relationship between districts' student performance on the state reading and math tests for the 2003-04 school year and their instructional spending allocations for the prior year. The red dotted line on this graph represents the 65% spending threshold. The black line is the regression line, which marks the average performance among all districts at each spending threshold. The regression line, also known as the "line of best fit," is positioned to minimize the distance between each district and the line. An upward slope in the regression line suggests a positive relationship between instructional spending allocations and performance. The relative significance of that relationship is captured by the "r-squared" value, with values closer to 1 signifying a stronger relationship, and values closer to 0 signifying a weaker relationship. For the great majority of states, the "r-squared" value is virtually equal to 0, indicating that there is no statistically significant relationship between the variables. Most importantly, in all states analyzed, there is an observable range in performance among districts at any given spending allocation.



About This Table: This table displays data relevant to the debate over the 65 Percent Solution. The first four columns identify and provide important demographic information for each district. The "Reading and Math Proficiency (RaMP)" column represents the average proficiency rate on all of the state reading and math tests administered in the district. The "Total Operating Expenditures" column represents the district's total operating budget (expressed on a per-student basis). The last four columns show how the district has allocated its operating budget across the functions most directly related to student instruction, as those functions are defined by National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). The "Change from 2002" column is provided to illustrate the trend in the district's spending on Instruction (i.e., Did the district's spending on instruction increase or decrease?).

The "Average District in State" row is provided for comparison purposes. The "average district" is the average of all districts in the state and represents the "typical" district. By contrast, the state average, which is used in the Addendum table, is essentially the average of all students in the state, so that districts with more students (i.e., larger districts) influence the state average more than do smaller districts. Both are useful comparative benchmarks. The data in this table were reported by the districts to the Census and the NCES. Some of the smallest districts in the state may not be represented because those districts are prohibited from publicly reporting student performance data.
